4.	After depositing of e-Service Fee, bidder is required to deposit Participation Fees i.e. Earnest Money Deposit (EMD).	(a) EMD Fees-605000 /-
5.	Date & Time Schedule of Online eAuction	Start from 11:00:00Hrs. (i.e. 11:00:00 AM) and Close at 15:00:00 Hrs. (i.e. 03:00:00 PM) on the schedule date i.e. on 18-02-2026.

IMPORTANT NOTE(S)

1. The Bidders can only participate by signing-up online (creating user account) on NIC eAuction Portal i.e. <https://eauction.gov.in>.
2. The photocopy of Demand Draft (DD) of e-Service fee and participation fees is required to upload on the e-Auction portal before stipulated time. The bidder will not be allowed to participate in the e Auction in case of non-uploading of required Demand Drafts (DD's).



GENERAL INFORMATION FOR BIDDERS

1. The bidders can download the e Auction document from the Portal : <https://eauction.gov.in>.
2. The intending bidders, before participation in the Online Auction/bidding process will be required to create their user ID and password at i.e. <https://eauction.gov.in>.

Steps to create user ID and password: -

- Go to Online bidder Enrollment link at eauction.gov.in
- Fill all the required information at online bidder enrollment page.
- After successfully creation of user ID and password of intending bidder required to login in eauction.gov.in.
- Link Digital Signature Certificate (D.S.C.) with intending bidder's account at eauction.gov.in.
- After Successful completion of above said points, the bidder will be able to go at their home page screen at eauction.gov.in and bidder can participate in e-auction.


3. For participation in Online Auction, he/she will be required to make offline payment of e-Service Fee & Participation Fees as per details provided on Page No.1. The bidder who fails to pay e-Service Fee & Participation fees within the stipulated period shall not be allowed to participate in the Online Auction.
4. The Bidders shall have to pay e-Service Fee in the shape of Demand Draft (DD) in favour of "Society for it initiative fund for E-Governance" and Participation Fees i.e. Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) shall have to deposit in the shape of demand draft in favour of Deputy Commissioner, Rohtak. Both Demand Drafts (DD's) are to be deposited in the office of District Nazar, O/o Deputy Commissioner, Rohtak by due date & time.
5. The interested bidders shall have to pay mandatorily the e-Service fee and Participation Fees i.e. Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) by bidders through Demand Draft(s) and photocopies of the Demand Draft(s) also have to be uploaded on e Auction portal. After verification of the said demand draft(s) the department will have to approve the same in e Auction portal, failing which the bidder will not be able to participate in the online auction.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR ONLINE AUCTION

Sr. No.	Details
1.	The various Condemned/scrap Vehicles will be sold on "AS IS WHERE IS BASIS" & "AS IS WHAT IT IS BASIS".
2.	Eligibility of participation in online auction: - Any individual above the age of 18 years can participate in online auction.
3.	Validity of Bid: - The validity of the offer will be for a period of <u>15 days</u> from the closing date of the online Auction.
4.	G.S.T. @ 18% or as applicable from time to time shall be charged extra from the successful bidder. The G.S.T. deposited once will not be refunded in any circumstance.
5.	It is the sole responsibility of the bidder to inspect the condemned/scrap vehicles "AS IS WHERE IS BASIS" & "AS IS WHAT IT IS BASIS" physically before participating in the Online Auction for the same.
6.	The Registration certificate will be given to the successful bidder, if applicable, as per Govt. Instructions.

8.	<p>Decision of Auction: - The decision of the e Auction will be as under: -</p> <p>a. After closing the Online Auction, the online bids received will be put up before the Rate Approval Committee under the Chairmanship of Chairman District Condemnation Board, Rohtak.</p> <p>The Committee will comprise the following members: -</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. Additional Deputy Commissioner, Rohtak (Chairman) ii. Executive Engineer, Mech. PWD (B&R), Rohtak (Member) iii. Workshop Manager, Haryana Roadways Rohtak (Member) <p>The above committee reserves the right to accept/reject any bid without assigning any reason thereof.</p> <p>b. Acceptance letters for rates shall be sent to the successful bidders on their registered e-mail IDs along with a copy of Intending Department.</p>
9.	Deposit of Sale Value of the Vehicles/other items: - The successful bidder will have to deposit the sale value of the condemned/scrap Vehicles etc. mentioned in the acceptance letter issued by the concerned Department/Govt. Agency within 03 working days (up to 5.00 PM of last working days) from the date of issue of acceptance letter of their highest quoted rate.
10.	<p>Deposit of G.S.T.: - The successful bidder will have to deposit GST @18% or as applicable from time to time of the Sale Value as under:</p> <p>(a) 2 Wheeler (Motorcycle/Scooter etc.), 3 Wheeler (Auto etc.), 4 Wheeler (Car, Jeep etc.) & above (Bus, Truck etc.):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. GST @ 18% will be charged if the old vehicles auctioned as scrap without Registration Certificate. ii. GST @ 18% will be charged on the item auctioned as scrap. <p>In the shape of Demand Draft (DD) issued in favour of Deputy Commissioner, Rohtak, payable at Rohtak within 3 working days (up to 5.00 PM of last working days) from the date of issue of acceptance letter.</p>



1.	<p>Release Order for Vehicles/other items: - On receipt of documentary proof of deposit of Sale Value and G.S.T. @18% or as applicable from time to time, the Intending Department will issue release order of Vehicle/other items to the purchaser.</p> <p>The purchaser shall have to lift the vehicles/other items within 15 days after issuance of release order. No grace period will be granted to the purchase. If the purchase does not lift the stores within the prescribed period of 15 days or extended period, a registered notice in format of Form CD-14 be issued by the Additional Deputy Commissioner, Rohtak. If the purchase fails to reply to the said registered notice of lift the material, the sale order is cancelled and the security/earnest money of the party is forfeited. However, in case of any justified reason submitted by the purchaser to the Additional Deputy Commissioner, Rohtak inwriting, in some cases, if found genuinely reasonable the Additional Deputy Commissioner, Rohtak will have to discretion to extend the lifting period only up to 03 days in Form CD-15, which should not be followed as a general practice.</p> <p>Further, where the tender whose offer has been accepted, does not deposit the requisite amount of applicable taxes within the time specified in the letter of acceptance, the acceptance is cancelled and the earnest money deposited by him is forfeited. In cases involving more than one items of store, if the tender deposit security/applicable taxes for only one item and does not deposit for others, his security deposit is forfeited after issuing the usual show cause notice.</p>
12.	Place of Delivery: - Consignee's site on "AS IS WHERE IS BASIS" & "AS IS WHAT IS BASIS".
13.	<p>Retaining/Not Retaining of Registration No. of Vehicle: -</p> <p>It is the sole discretion of the intending department as to whether they wish to retain the Registration No. of the vehicle or not.</p> <p>(a) If the intending department retains the Registration No. of the vehicles then new number will be provided by the concerned department at the time of transfer of the Registration Certificate (RC).</p> <p>(b) If the intending department allows transferring of the Registration No. of the vehicles to the bidder then the bidder has to deposit the requisite Govt. Fees to the Transport Department for obtaining the particular number at the time of transfer of the Registration Certificate (RC).</p>
14.	<p>Refund of Participation Fees (EMD): - The amount will be refunded through <u>Demand Draft(DD)/Cheque/NEFT/RTGS</u> to the unsuccessful bidder: -</p> <p>(a) In case of unsuccessful bidders (whose rates are not Highest), the demand draft of the participation fees (EMD) will be returned within 30 days from the closing date of Online Auction through <u>Demand Draft (DD)/Cheque /NEFT/RTGS</u>.</p> <p>(b) In case of successful bidders whose rates have been accepted and acceptance letter has been issued to the bidder, their Participation Fees (EMD) shall be retained till completion of payment process. Once the successful bidder deposits the Sale Value of the Vehicle/other items along with G.S.T. @ 18% or as applicable time to time within the specified time period and finally the release order of the vehicle and other items is issued in their favour, their Participation Fees (EMD) shall be automatically refunded through electronic mode directly in their accounts as per details provided by them.</p>
15.	<p>Forfeiture of Participation Fees (EMD): -</p> <p>(a) Before closing of the e Auction i.e. during the bidding process: - Participation Fees (EMD) will be forfeited if the bidder withdraws or amends the rates under any circumstances.</p> <p>(b) After issuance of the Acceptance Letter: - Participation Fees i.e. Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) will be forfeited if the bidder fails to deposit the requisite Sale Value of Vehicle and other items along with G.S.T. @ 18% or as applicable time to time within the stipulated period after issuance of the acceptance letter in his/her favour.</p>
16.	The decision of the District Condemnation Board, Rohtak reserve the right to accept/reject any bid without assigning any reasons thereof.
17.	All the cases of dispute, if any, will be settled subject to jurisdiction of respective districts.
