rived at the village and abducted them and killed him. We have not been able to pinpoint those responsible yet, and no one has taken responsibility either. The investigation is ongoing," said the SP.

According to a security official in Churachandpur, they have learnt that two individuals abducted the couple and took them in an SUV to a spot where there were two more people, all of them masked. Haokip was pushed out of the vehicle around a kilometre before the site at which the killing took place. The body was retrieved and taken to the morgue at the district hospital, and is expected to be handed over to his family in Kakching later on Thursday. The official also stated that multiple parties of the police, Army, CRPF and Assam Rifles conducted combing operations in the area on Thursday.

Another police official said that the deceased had arrived at Churachandpur on December 19 and had been staying with the Kuki-Zos in the majority.

"We got in touch with his wife and found that he had been staying at the village for the past month. The locals, including the village authorities, were aware. He does not normally live in Manipur; he works and lives in Nepal. Then yesterday, some armed miscreants ar-

apprehended within three days.

This killing comes during a period of relative calm in Manipur. President's Rule in the state will complete one year on February 14, and there are ongoing discussions and efforts to build consensus on the formation of a popular government in the state. A meeting last week was attended by representatives of Kuki-Zo insurgent groups that are signatories to the Suspension of Operation (SoO) agreements, MLAs from the community, and a civil society organisation called the Kuki-Zo Council.

A resolution was passed setting conditions for the formation of a new popular government in the state. It included a written "political commitment" by the state and central governments on a separate Union Territory for Kuki-Zo-majority areas of the state, and finalising a settlement before the expiration of the regular tenure of the current Legislative Assembly, which ends in 2027. One of the major SoO groups, the Kuki National Organisation, issued a statement on Thursday stating they were not involved in the incident, saying that "under no circumstances is any spouse of our people from any other community ever subjected to such activity".

The ripples of the incident were felt in the Meitei-majority valley, where a Joint Action Committee was formed by locals. It demanded that the case be handed over to the NIA and warned that they will launch an agitation if the culprits are not

tured in the video took place around 7:30 pm on Wednesday, and identified the man as Mayanglambam Rishikanta, who originally hailed from Kakching Khunou in Manipur's Meitei-majority valley. The SP said that the incident took place at a village called Natjang, located a few kilometres away from Tuibong, where the deceased had been living with his wife, Chingnu Haokip. The place of occurrence is a 30-minute drive from Churachandpur town, where the Kuki-Zos are in the majority.

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## ECI launches new app for voters, officials; CEC offers other countries help to develop similar platform

The CEC launched the app on day two of the EC's ongoing three-day international conference for election management bodies and experts here. Addressing the foreign delegates, he extended the offer - that ECI could work with their election management bodies to develop a similar app as per their election laws and language.

"With the advent of technol-

ogy and the accelerated information that passes through citizens through various media interfaces, all election management bodies in the plenary [session of conference] yesterday were worried about misinformation. How do we address it? ECI-Net is one tool," Kumar said.

A beta version of the app was launched last year and was used for the Bihar Assembly elections and Special Intensive Revision

of electoral rolls. So far, the app has been used to process over 10 crore electoral registration forms and digitise 150 crore documents for the ongoing SIR, the ECI said. The app, which is available in 23 languages and developed by ECI and Tata Consultancy Services, allows citizens to fill registration forms, file claims and objections, view voter turnout on polling day and follow the results on counting day.
