

AUTHORITIES ALERT PUBLIC AFTER TIGER SPOTTED NEAR YADAGIRIGUTTA

Hyderabad, Jan.27: Authorities have issued an alert to residents of Yadagirigutta and surrounding areas after a tiger was spotted roaming on the outskirts of the town. For some time, unexplained deaths of cows and goats in the region had raised concerns. The presence of the tiger was later confirmed after it was captured on 'trap cameras' installed in the Yataipalli forest area near Yadagirigutta. Forest officials believe the tiger may have strayed from the Amrabhad forest region, possibly in search of a mate. Officials have urged the people to remain vigilant, avoid venturing into forest areas, and immediately inform authorities if the animal is sighted. Efforts are underway to closely track the tiger's movement and ensure public safety.

BRS FLAGS 'SINGARENI SCAM'; SEEKS CBI OR JUDICIAL PROBE

Hyderabad, Jan.27: A delegation of the Bharat Rashtra Samithi (BRS), led by working president K.T. Rama Rao, met the Governor at Lok Bhavan here on Tuesday and submitted a memorandum alleging large-scale corruption and financial irregularities in the Singareni Collieries Company Limited (SCCL) under the Congress government.

The BRS delegation comprising MPs, MLAs, MLCs and senior party leaders, submitted documentary evidence alleging misuse of public funds, irregular tendering practices and inflated costs in Singareni's mining and solar power projects.

Speaking to the media, KTR accused the government of evading answers despite repeated disclosures by BRS leaders, including T. Harish Rao. He alleged that tenders were cancelled and reissued with a new "Site Visit Certification" clause, resulting in escalated project costs.

Nearly Rs.10 crore of Singareni funds were diverted for non-core purposes and alleged that solar projects were awarded at nearly Rs.7 crore per MW, far higher than the national average of Rs.2.5 - 3 crore per megawatt, he charged. He also flagged a reported 30 per cent hike in explosives prices and alleged selective action against Singareni officials who raised objections.

He demanded that the government release a White Paper detailing the number of companies that conducted site visits over the past nine months, communications received by Singareni, certificates issued, and the criteria used for contractor selection. Stating that Singareni was jointly owned by the Telangana government (51 per cent) and the Government of India (49 per cent), and that all funds involved are public money, the BRS urged the Governor to recommend an independent probe by the CBI or a sitting judge into the alleged irregularities.
