CM tells bureaucrats to prioritise spending, rationalise expenditure

At high-level meeting, Pinarayi lays emphasis on health, paying social security pension

IN response to the reduction in borrowing limit imposed by the Centre, the state government has decided to prioritise spending and rationalise expenditure. Chief Minister Pinarayi Vijayan chaired a high-level meeting on Tuesday to review the state's major programmes and financial position. Additional Chief Secretary (Finance) Bishwanath Sinha presented a report highlighting the need to rationalise expenditure, and the CM instructed officials to prioritise benefits for common people. Emphasis was placed on social security pension payments and the health sector, and officials were advised to exercise prudent spending to make up for the shortfall.

The meeting also aimed to ensure the smooth functioning of the government and the implementation of development and welfare activities during the CM's upcoming foreign trip, as well as in the absence of top bureaucrats. However, the state government has not received a response from the Central Department of Expenditure regarding the reasons for the cut in the net borrowing ceiling (NBC) on open market borrowings (OMBs). This year, the state's NBC for the first nine months was set at ₹15,390 crore, compared to the previous year's cap of ₹23,915 crore. Finance Minister K N Balagopal had stated earlier that the Centre did not provide the calculation sheet along with the sanction letter on NBC. Last year's sanction letter included a calculation sheet listing the reasons for the reduction, which primarily involved off-budget borrowings. While the state government is unaware of the exact NBC for the entire fiscal year, Union

Minister V Muralidharan previously stated that the figure was ₹20,521 crore. According to Balagopal, Kerala received sanction for OMBs amounting to ₹23,915 crore for the first nine months of the fiscal year 2022-23, along with ₹912 crore for the last quarter. However, this year the state was expecting sanction for approximately ₹20,000 crore for the first nine months. The state's finance secretary recently wrote to their central counterpart, requesting the calculation sheet to understand the reasons for the reduction. It is believed that off-budget borrowings by the Kerala Infrastructure Investment Fund Board and the Kerala Social Security Pension Limited are the factors contributing to the cut in the borrowing limit.



AI cameras detect 49,000 violations on second day

THE Motor Vehicles Department (MVD) detected over 49,000 traffic offences using the AI-camera surveillance network on Tuesday. The MVD tabulated the numbers from the offences registered from 12am till 5pm. Thiruvananthapuram (8,454) recorded the most violations, while Alappuzha (1,252) reported the lowest.

However, MVD faced a glitch in the software responsible for generating e-challans, resulting in the suspension of their postal issuance. The department had initially planned to send out 25,000 challans per day. Between 8am and 5pm on Monday, MVD had recorded nearly 29,000 violations. A similar trend was observed on Tuesday, with a total of 29,134 violations detected during the same time period.

The number of offences remained consistent on the second day. It is worth noting that the number of violations has significantly decreased since the MVD began issuing penalties for offences starting from June 5.

IMD predicts moderate rain in state till June 10

ISOLATED heavy rainfall is expected in the state until June 10, according to the latest update from the Indian Meteorological Department (IMD). However, the weather office has refrained from providing a specific date for the onset of the southwest monsoon. Over the next five days, the forecast indicates fairly widespread rainfall with moderate intensity, accompanied by thunderstorms and winds across the state. In light of these conditions, fishermen have been advised to avoid venturing into the sea during this period. The delay in the onset of the monsoon is attributed, in part, to the formation of a deep depression that is expected to intensify into a cyclonic storm named 'Biparjoy' by Wednesday.

On specific dates, the IMD has issued yellow alerts for different districts in Kerala. On June 7, Alappuzha and Pathanamthitta have been given a yellow alert. On June 8, the alert extends to Alappuzha and Ernakulam. On June 9, Kollam and Thiruvananthapuram are expected to experience heightened rainfall, followed by Idukki and Pathanamthitta on June 10. Although the southwest monsoon usually arrives in Kerala around June 1 with a standard deviation of about seven days, this year it missed the predicted onset date of June 4.

CPI to discuss C Divakaran's remarks on LDF's protest

THE CPI state leadership will take up veteran C Divakaran's controversial remarks on LDF's Secretariat blockade against the solar scam in 2013 in his autobiography *Kanalvazhikal*. The issue was raised at the state executive on Tuesday by the members from Thiruvananthapuram.

"Divakaran has every right to write an autobiography," a leader reportedly said at the meeting. "However, by making controversial remarks about the protests organised by LDF, he has put CPI and the Left front in a tight spot," he said. At the meeting, CPI state secretary Kanam Rajendran said the matter will be discussed in the next state executive. In his book, Divakaran had alleged that the LDF's secretariat blockade was withdrawn without proper consultation. His remarks against the solar scam inquiry commission also kicked up a controversy. Speaking to news channels, he alleged that the commission did not act well.

All eyes now on Samastha meet as CIC backs Faizy

THE Co-ordination of Islamic Colleges (CIC) has vehemently denied all the accusations levelled by the Samastha Kerala Jem-Iyyathul Ulama against its former general secretary Abdul Hakeem Faizy, and has expressed unwavering support for him. One of the resolutions adopted at the Senate meeting emphasised that the CIC is an educational institution with a 25-year history, and its previous activities have been sincere. The resolution said, "This

meeting rejects all the allegations against CIC's ideological purity and against Abdul Hakeem Faizy Adrusseri's ideological commitment, Islamic belief, and his respect for the Prophet." Another resolution urged all parties concerned to refrain from obstructing the smooth functioning of educational institutions affiliated with CIC, it would disrupt the students' education. The affiliated institutions had an agreement with CIC to provide

all facilities to students. The resolution condemned certain institutions for breaching this agreement. The third resolution rejected the allegation that the syllabus of Wafy-Wafiyah courses contains elements contrary to Sunni ideology. Following the meeting, IUML state president Panakkad Syed Sadiq Ali Thangal, who also serves as CIC president, spoke to reporters and said he had presented the suggestions from Samastha to the CIC Senate, which were wholeheartedly accepted. He added, "There will now be another round of discussions with

Samastha leaders before announcing the final decision." IUML national general secretary P K Kunhalikutty, who initiated the compromise talks, was also present at the Senate meeting. The suggestions presented during the meeting included revoking the resignations of the 119 individuals who had resigned in solidarity with Hakeem Faizy and approving the appointment of Habeebulla Faizy as the new CIC general secretary.

Hakeem was asked to refrain from participating in CIC activities. It remains to be seen how Samastha will respond to CIC's gestures, considering that the resolutions are seen as a direct challenge to the organisation.

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Resolutions baseless, says Sadiq Ali Thangal
Sadiq Ali Shihab Thangal later issued a statement saying the resolutions being circulated in the name of the CIC were baseless. It has been decided that the CIC will function as per the directions of the Samastha and all CIC institutions should follow the directives of Samastha, Thangal said.
