

Pak couple's India dream ends in tragedy as they die while crossing border



THE DECOMPOSED bodies of a Pakistani couple were discovered in the desert near the Tanot Police Station area of Jaisalmer, Rajasthan on June 28. According to officials, the couple had tried to enter India illegally through the desert.

About 50 feet away, the body of a woman was found. Initial investigations suggest the couple likely died of dehydration.

Two Pakistani national identity cards were recovered from the man's clothing. One identified him as Ravi Kumar (17), son of Dewan Jee, while the second identified the woman as Shanti Bai (15), daughter of Gulooji.


According to Dilip Singh, Pakista, district coordinator of Hindu Pakistan Displaced Union and Border People's Organisation while talking to *The Indian Express* said that the organisation contacted a distant relative of the couple in India who told them, "The man had some disagreement with his father. So, he left home with his wife. The couple were residents of Sindh province in Pakistan which is 60-kms from the Indian border. They had applied for an Indian visa around 1.5 years back but their visa was not approved."

"He wanted to live in India. He somehow entered Indian territory but unfortunately died," said Sodha, who circulated the details of the ID cards on social media and came in contact with the boy's relatives in Jaisalmer, who confirmed his identity. Due to the advanced state of decomposition, the bodies can't be sent to Pakistan. Hence, the Hindu Pakistani Displaced Union will perform the cremation. The bodies have been kept at the mortuary of CHC, Ramgarh after post-mortem.

Schoolgirl dies of suspected snakebite; parents allege delay in transfer to hospital

Palghar: A Class V student died from suspected snakebite in a school in Wada in Palghar district, a police official said on Monday. The incident took place on June 26 and the deceased has been identified as 11-year-old Vedika Zate, said Wada police station senior inspector Datta Kindre. "Her peers have said she died of snakebite. The post-mortem report is awaited. An accidental death report has been registered as of now," he added.

The child's parents accused the school of delay in rushing her to hospital.
