## Punjab DGP ridicules SFJ's Pannun: claims responsibility even when nothing on ground

PUNJAB POLICE chief Gaurav Yadav Wednesday ridiculed USbased wanted fugitive and Khalistan separatist Gurpatwant Singh Pannun saying "a social media post comes up" claiming responsibility for an attack in state even when it is not clear whether any such incident has

taken place or not. "These people have failed to achieve their aim. If you see Gurpatwant Pannun's videos, there is nothing on ground while he makes wild claims. We do not take anything lightly, we take it very seriously. But in

many instances we have seen that it is not even clear whether a blast has taken place or not but a social media post comes up claiming its responsibility," Yadav said.

Pannun, who heads the outlawed Sikhs for Justice, has in the past claimed responsibility of attacks carried out in Punjab.

The DGP's remarks came while answering questions from the media on the spate of grenade attacks in the state in past few months.

Answering a question on why intelligence wing of the police could not forewarn about the attacks, the DGP said the situation poses many challenges. "We are sitting on the border

with a neighbouring country whose intelligence agency (ISI) finds Punjab to be a fertile ground. They want to bleed India by a thousand cuts. If you see the history of Punjab, we have faced a challenging time." he said.

Yadav said that the incidents of blasts and grenade attacks in border districts of the state were being perpetrated with an aim of spreading the narrative that

Punjab is unsafe but this will not be allowed to succeed.

The DGP said that there had been 12 incidents of blasts till now and all have been traced in a very scientific manner using CCTV footage and mobile tower call detail dumps.

"I am not mininising or overemphasising the situation but a handful of people are spreading narrative that Punjab is not safe. We are totally determined to crush this narrative and want to emphasise that Punjab is safe. Any person who deals in nefarious activities will be dealt with," he said.

Answering a question as the motivation of those who were carrying out these attacks,

Yadav said he did not want to give the planners of these attacks any importance by taking their names publicly. The DGP said that the architects of these blasts are acting through cutout modules. "The masterminds are based abroad. Some are drug addicts, some are petty criminals. Very few are ideolog-

The DGP said that blasts are mostly taking place in Amritsar and Gurdaspur because the masterminds sitting abroad managing these activities belong to these two districts. "The foot soldiers used to carry out these attacks are living close to the target of attack. Mostly they are within 25-30 kms radius of the

place attacked," said the DGP. The latest grenade blast oc-

curred near the residence of a policeman in Dera Baba Nanak, Gurdaspur district, Punjab, on the evening of February 17. The explosion happened in Raimal village and was described as low-intensity with no reported damage or casualties.

Happy Passia of Babbar Khalsa group claimed responsibility for this incident. Police and forensic teams were dispatched to the scene to investigate, with authorities exploring motives related to gang rivalries or terrorist involvement. The incident has heightened security concerns in the area due to the targeting of police personnel.
