

CM has put Sundargarh on the world stage: Pandian

Chief Minister Naveen Patnaik insisted on hosting the second Mens Hockey World Cup 2023 and also that Rourkela should be one of the venues thereby putting Sundargarh district on international stage, said 5T Chairman V K Pandian.



Rourkela as a mark of respect towards Sundargarh's contribution towards Indian Hockey hosted the World Cup and the record time in which the stadium, accommodation and airport was constructed has been lauded by the international hockey fraternity.

The Birsra Munda Hockey stadium was constructed in 15 months and achieved a record

entry in the Guinness book for being the largest seated hockey stadium in the world, he noted. Mr Pandian said this while interacting with people in Sundargarh and Balisankara block on Wednesday.

Since my last visit on 12 March 2023, based on petitions and feedback, Rs 330 crores has been sanctioned in Sundargarh Assembly Constituency and Rs 197 Crores sanctioned in Talsara Assembly Constituency, he said. He reviewed major development projects including the Mega Lift Irrigation Projects at Semina, Riughat, Khairidih and Satara; Mega Piped water supply schemes; Instream storage structures; important bridges etc.

Odisha Gov seeks and gets 3 advisors

In a rather unusual development as far as Odisha is concerned, Governor Raghubar Das sought and secured appointment of three persons of his choice as his advisors.

Retired bureaucrat Santosh Kumar Satpathy who had been private secretary to CM Naveen Patnaik more than two decades ago before he returned to his parent cadre state of Jharkhand and was also posted as secretary to the then Governor of Jharkhand, Droupadi Murmu, has now been picked as Chief Advisor to Governor Raghubar Das. Prof Shukla Mahanty, has been made advisor to the Governor (academic



matters) while Subrat Kumar Mohanty is the advisor to the Governor (Media and IT related matters). The notification in this regard was issued on Wednesday. Many people in the know here failed to immediately recall any previous such appointment of advisors to the Governor in the recent past.

Private hospital blast toll rises to two

An explosion in a private hospital here on 29 December 29 has claimed another life with a man who was seriously injured succumbing on Wednesday, the police said.

With the death of Sritam Sahu (23) who hailed from Delang village in Puri district, the toll in the blast rose to two.

Two other injured persons are under treatment at the same hospital and their condition is stated to be stable, the police said.

The explosion of a cylinder used for filling refrigerator

gas in air-conditioners at the hospital left four people injured.

Dilip Samantaray, an AC mechanic, died two days after the blast. His wife Somyashree had gone into depression following her husband's death and allegedly died by suicide on Monday.

"Our AC maintenance work is carried out every year through a third party agency. On that day, the mechanics were working on the rooftop. Due to a short-circuit, the explosion occurred and four workers suffered serious burn injuries," said Jyotiranjan Panda, chief operating officer of the hospital.

Two killed two injured in road accidents

Two persons, including a school boy, were killed and two others injured in separate road accidents in Bhadrak district, police said.

A speeding car from Puri heading towards Kolkata hit a motorcycle on a stretch of National Highway-16, causing the two-wheeler to fall from a bridge on Tuesday evening, they said.

One of the bike riders,



Alok Mohanty (25), died in hospital after the incident, while another suffered injuries, police said.

The condition of the injured woman is critical, a police officer said. The car driver has been detained, he

said. In another incident on Tuesday, a loaded tractor ran over two school boys at Dhangar Chowk on Agarpada-Bonth road in the district, police said.

The deceased has been identified as Aditya Kesari Jena (10). The accident took place when the two minors were returning from school, they said. The injured boy is undergoing treatment in hospital, and his condition is serious, police said.

Three fresh Covid cases

With three more active cases detected in the State in the last 24 hours, the Covid case tally has gone up to 27, said an official of the health department on Tuesday.

The infectedes did not require hospitalization and are in home isolation under the medical supervision of the

health department. They are recovering fast. All the cases of illnesses are mild and self-limiting, said an official of the health department.

There is no cause of immediate worry. The State has reported only 27 coronavirus cases since November including the fresh reported cases. The situation is being closely monitored.

Girl ends life as a youth threatens to make intimate pictures viral

A 21 year old college girl hanged herself to death from a ceiling fan at a village under Kendrapara Sadar police station jurisdiction in Kendrapara district on Tuesday night as her lover threatened to make her intimate pictures and videos viral in the social media platforms.

The mother of the victim girl filed an FIR in the police station on Wednesday and

alleged that blackmailing by a youth Rudra Prasad Das (25) led her daughter to hang herself. The accused threatened to make the intimate pictures of her daughter viral.

The accused allegedly took intimate pictures of the girl and threatened to use the picture if she denied physical relations. When she refused, the accused showed some of the intimate photos to some of friends and threatened to make her intimate pictures and videos

viral on social media platforms.

"Acting on the FIR, police started an investigation. Preliminary investigation revealed that the accused Rudra Prasad Das threatened to upload some photos of the victim girl with him on the social site to tarnish her name. Police seized the mobile phone of the victim girl", said Saroj Sahu, Inspector Kendrapara Sadar police station. The accused has absconded.

OOA bags first prize in All India Annual Conference

This year OOA decided to train about basic life support to road traffic accident patients on the side at the accident site to traffic police, police on duty, ambulance drivers, High School, and college students so that they can save life of many patients dying at accident place. OOA members work actively and train in different places to around 5000 members.

Decomposed carcass of an elephant found in Kuldiha sanctuary

A decomposed carcass of an elephant was found at Sunakhani inside Kuldiha wildlife sanctuary of Balasore district. The forest personnel on patrol found the carcass on Tuesday.

DFO Khushwant Singh said he believed that the elephant had died 20 days ago. Three veterinary officials have conducted the autopsy of the decomposed carcass on Wednesday in presence of forest officials and honorary wildlife warder, PS member of Shyamsundarpur GP and disposed of adhering guidelines in force.

The DFO said that during the investigation no foreign body or material was detected in the carcass using a metal detector. Three samples collected are being sent to the Centre for Wildlife Health, OUAT to ascertain the actual cause of death, age and gender of the elephant carcass.

ECoR GM reviews Khurda Rd-Daspalla rly section

East Coast Railway (ECoR) General Manager, Manoj Sharma inspected Khurda Road-Daspalla Railway Section of Khurda Road-Balangir Rail Line project on Wednesday and reviewed the Safety and passenger amenity works along with ongoing infrastructure related works in the Railway Section. He took stock of progress of various passenger amenities works, development of parking area, circulating area, landscaping etc., and also reviewed the status of various infrastructure related works at Daspalla Railway Station. Out of the 301 km length of the Khurda Road-Balangir Rail Line project, a total of 152.8 km has been completed, including approximately 105 km from Khurda Road to Dasapalla and about 47KMs from Balangir to Sonapur. ECoR also aims to complete 73 more kms rail line from Sonapur to Purunakatak in 2024. Reliable sources said Railway Minister Ashwini Vaishnaw is likely to inaugurate the Dasapalla-Khurda Rd section and the Dasapalla station in two days time.
