THE PUNJAB government has

sought legal opinion from Advocate General Gurminder Singh Gerry, days after Punjab Governor Banwarilal Purohit wrote to Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann asking him why Cabinet Minister Aman Arora – convicted recently in a family dispute case – has not been divested of his membership of the state assembly despite the Supreme Court's direc-

Chief Secretary Anurag Verma has asked the AG to give his legal opinion on the matter, multiple sources in the government said.

"The government wants to check if Arora can continue to be member of the legislative Assembly. We will see what the Constitution says," a source privy to the discussions said.

After the legal opinion, the issue would be put up to the CM, who returned to Chandigarh Monday after his meditation and business trip to Andhra Pradesh. "The CM will have a meeting on the issue on Tuesday," said a source. The source added that it also needs to be checked whether the power to disqualify an MLA, convicted for two years, rests with the Speaker of the

Vidhan Sabha or not. Speaker Kultar Sandhwan, meanwhile, said, "The law will take its own course".

Under the provisions of the Representation of the People Act (RPA) 1951, any public representative sentenced to imprison-

Governor also cited the the judgment of Supreme Court in the case of Lilly Thomas versus Union of India, as per which "the members of legislative Assembly (MLAs) stand divested of their membership if convicted and sentenced to imprisonment for a term not less than two years by a trial court".

Purohit also said the representation — by the Shiromani Akali Dal — had also raised the question of national flag hoisting by Arora on January 26. The representation alleged that the act of entrusting the legislator with the symbolic representation of the nation on a day as momentous as Republic Day not only undermines the sanctity of the legal system but also sends an unsettling message to the citizenry regarding the government's commitment to ethical governance, he said.

The court of sub-divisional Judicial Magistrate, Sunam, had last month convicted Arora and eight others in a 2008 case filed on the complaint of the minister's brother-in-law Rajinder

The court while pronouncing the verdict convicted Arora under sections 323 and 323 read with 149 IPC for one year RI, under section 452 IPC and 452 read with 149 IPC for two years RI, and 148 IPC. Arora had then said that he would move the higher court against his conviction. He

was granted bail the same day. Arora told The Indian Express on Monday that he would be moving district court and file an appeal against the lower court's judgment.

# university after more than 130 'fail' in one subject

AN INDEFINITE sit-in by international students, mostly of Punjabi origin, outside Algoma University in Canada's Brampton city entered day 4 on Sunday. The students say an information technology professor has flunked over 130 international students in what they allege is part of a ploy to mint money in re-examination fees. The Montreal Youth Students

Organisation (MYSO) and many social activists have extended support to the students protesting in the bone-chilling cold weather. "On Saturday and Sunday, students along with MYSO members took out protest marches in the downtown of Brampton to gain public support. Students have also sent emails to the education department of Canada in this connection," Mandeep, convener of MYSO, told The Indian Express. "On Monday, a day-long protest



march will be taken out in Brampton and we appeal to likeminded groups to join the struggle of students."

Balli Singh, a students committee member of the university, said, "The annual grading system needs changes and the university needs to consider our demand. We want a transparent system of paper-checking and students shouldn't be burdened

with the extra fee for appearing for an exam yet again.'

Students —many from Punjab — protest at Canada

Praveen Gill, another students committee member, said, "Strict action needs to be taken against the professor who has played with the future of so many students, especially of international origin."

Manpreet Kaur Longowal, a MYSO volunteer, said, "There are 10 subjects in the IT graduation

course. It is surprising that the students have passed all the nine subjects with good marks. They have even cleared the practical of the Techniques of a System Analyst paper but failed in its theory exam, which is very surprising. A thorough inquiry needs to be done in this case."

Meanwhile, the university has said that an investigation is underway. "We've contacted every student protesting grades from one specific instructor. Taking their concerns seriously, the Dean of Science is leading an urgent investigation. We acknowledge the stress these students face. We value academic integrity and the faculty of science is intervening to ensure fair assessments for each student," it said in a statement.

Khushpal Grewal, another MYSO volunteer, said, "After the struggle of students of Algoma University, we came to know that in many colleges of Ontario as well, students are facing similar problems. They have been failed in one subject, due to

which they can't get admission in the next semester till they clear the failed subject. This amounts to a burden of 3,000 dollars or even more than that We find this to be part of a conspiracy by colleges to mint money from international students who are already paying

four times more fees than the Canadian students." Mandeep said that letters had been sent to the members of the Canadian parliament seeking justice for students and a

thorough investigation. Harinder Mehrok, another MYSO volunteer, said, "Already international students contribute 30 billion dollars annually to Canada's GDP. Many colleges and universities are surviving on international students only. Elected representatives need to see the interests of international students as well and provide justice."

Rajpal Kaur, a students committee member of the university, called for a permanent solution to such issues.
